Students receive continuing education, counseling, self-advocacy training and career experience. For students who have IEPs calling for related services and specially designed instruction, services are available. Classes in current events, healthy lifestyles, and human social development are offered to all students, along with community based activities and recreational opportunities.

The Transition Center offers three cohorts:

- Post-Secondary Education Cohort: Support for students preparing to attend or currently enrolled in a post-secondary education program such as a local community college, four-year college or university, certified trade school or Vo-Tech.
- Workforce Development Cohort: Support for students beginning paid work in the competitive employment sector or seeking community based guided work opportunities.
- Vocational/Life Skills Cohort: For students bridging to work, housing and community support from adult agencies.
