













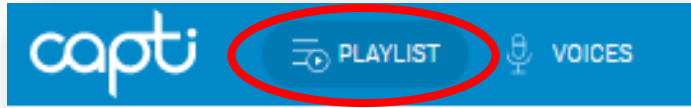

Use Capti to listen to books, articles, and more on multiple devices, even without an internet connection!

Identified students are provided with a premium school account. (There is also a free version that can be utilized by students who are not identified for a premium school account.)

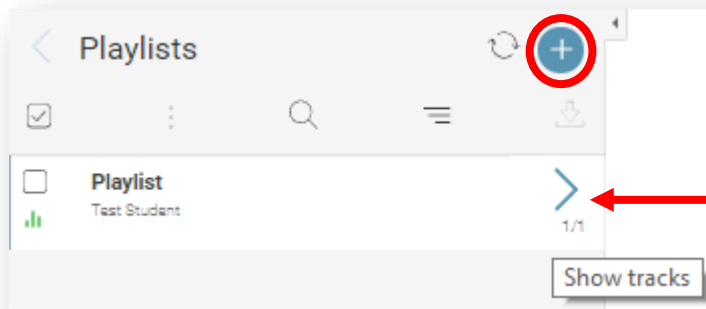

PLAYLIST is where you will find any tracks/items saved for you to read.

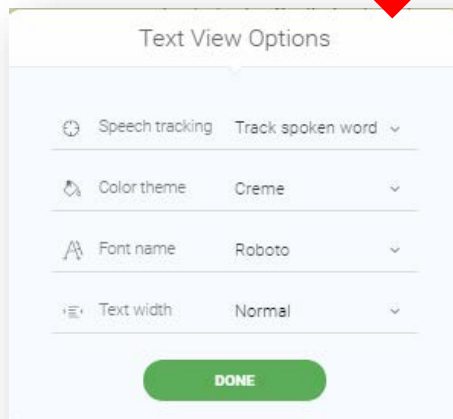
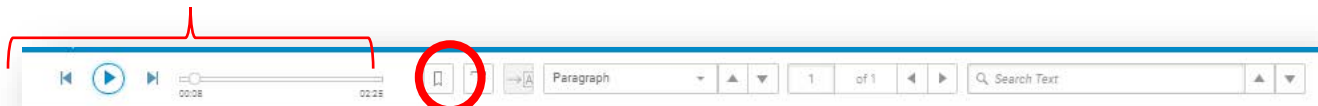
Teachers may share playlists with students, or students may create and add to their own playlists.



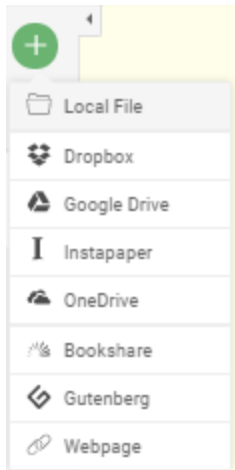
Click on the  to create a new PLAYLIST.


Click on the arrow to open a PLAYLIST and view the tracks.

Once a track is open, use the toolbar to listen and navigate through the text, add bookmarks.



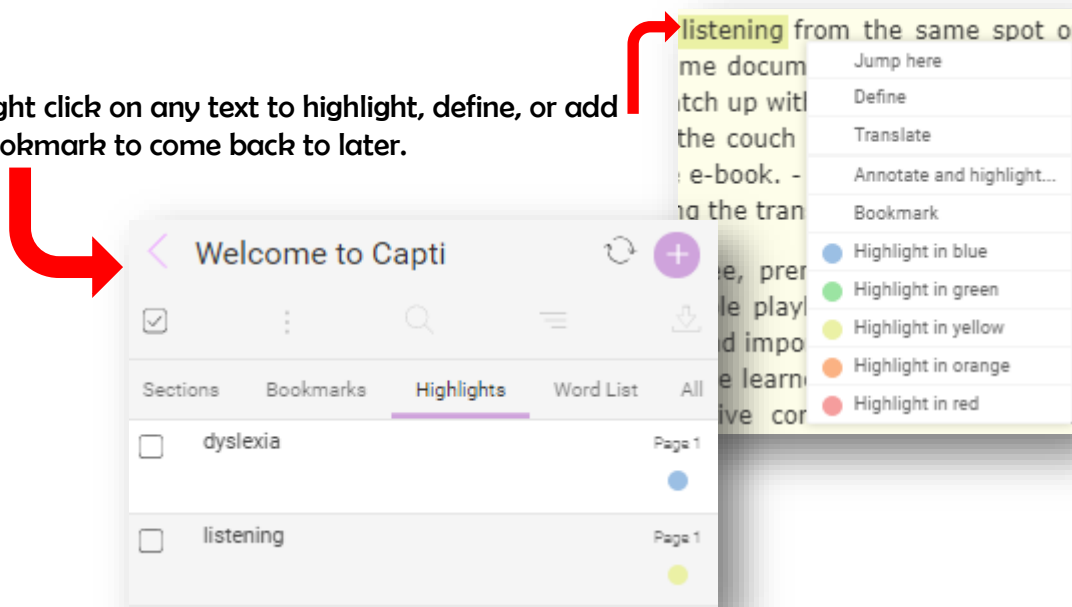
Text View Options allow you to set the tracking on/off, colors, fonts, and paragraph width.



Click on the  to add tracks to your Playlist. Tracks can be added from a wide variety of sources such as webpages, Bookshare, and uploading from the local computer.

Once items are added as Tracks, the text can be read aloud.

Right click on any text to highlight, define, or add bookmark to come back to later.

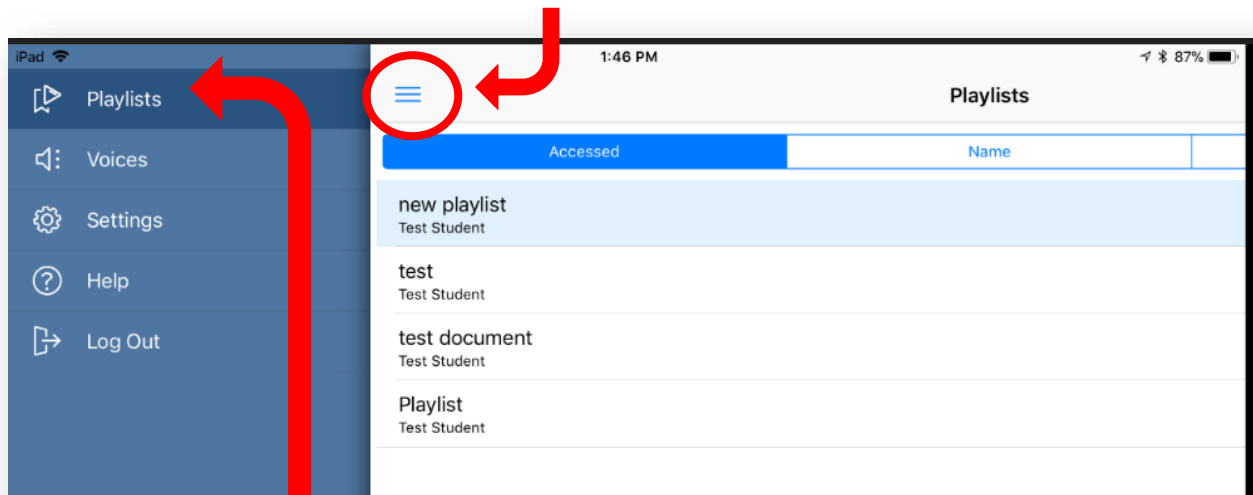

## iPad Use:



Login using CaptiVoice K-12 app for school accounts. *(Note: Capti general app can be used for free accounts not associated with our school account.)*

Tap on the menu to access Playlists, Settings and more.



Tap the Playlist to open tracks.

Click play button to listen to track.
